



Stover Ranch Combo Hunt Packing Information

Packing Information:

We are expecting the weather to be mild, average temperatures are in the 60's for the high and in the 50s for a low. But as always weather can be unpredictable, so it is best to dress in layers and come prepared for warmer or cooler temps. If you would like to check the weather as your hunt gets closer Willow Creek, CA is the closest town to the ranch. You will travel on the ranch in a 4WD truck or ATV. We suggest you bring the following items:

- Normal hunting clothes (hunter orange not required)
- Hiking boots
- Light rain gear
- Rifle
- **Non-Lead** ammunition (required per CA Law effective 7/1/2019)
- Binoculars, camera/video
- Day pack
- Sunscreen and toiletries
- Sleeping Bag (we do have some, but if you prefer your own please bring it)
- **CA Hunting License, B Zone Deer Tag, and Bear Tag**
- **Trophy Fees – \$1,500 will apply to a deer 130 SCI or larger and \$1,000 will apply to a bear 6' and over.**

The cabin has hot running water, full bathroom facilities, a propane refrigerator, and propane lights. There is no electricity, so if you need to plug something in it will require a car adapter. Cell phone service on the ranch is spotty, but if you have AT&T or Verizon there are places on the ranch that you will be able to make/receive calls.

We supply soft drinks, bottled water, juice, beer and wine. If you prefer a mixed drink in the evenings, you are welcome to bring your own liquor. **Absolutely no alcohol is allowed in the field at any time while hunting.**
